VOLUNTEER POSITIONS AVAILABLE

PLEASE COME TO REGISTRATION WITH YOUR FIRST OPTION AND A SECOND INCASE THE FIRST IS ALREADY FILLED. THIS IS FOR THOSE NOT LISTED AS TEACHING ABOVE.

Substitute teachers- be available each of the 10 weeks for all 3 periods. You will most likely be used each week and sometimes for more than one period. Do not take this position if you cannot plan to be at all 10 weeks of classes.

Assistant teachers- many of our younger classes and those classes that need another adult will be listed on a sign-up sheet and per the request of teachers. You'll need to be at every one of the classes and call for a substitute if you are ever going to be absent.

Creation night team- you will need to be there by 5:00 pm that night to help before, during and after. You will need to stand for most of that time. Cleaning up bathrooms, mopping and sweeping are also part of this position. This is a good option for those that can't come each Tuesday.

Set-up and take-down teams-these are separate teams and you only need to sign-up for one. You will need to be able to carry tables, chairs, clean-up bathrooms, empty garbage cans, vacuum, etc. These ladies will

count on you to do your part every Tuesday.

Nursery workers- because so many of our moms with babies and toddlers teach, we provide them with a nursery. With this position you'll take care of little ones. There will be about 3 other ladies in the two rooms to help also. You'll be counted on to be on time every week.

IMPORTANT: Like in the spring, you will receive a card when you sign up for a position and you must have that to complete your paperwork with the staff. Teachers listed automatically qualify as a volunteer. Everyone else look for the volunteer sign-up table when you enter the front of the church. Your card will be given to you on registration day. Again, come early to sign-up if you are not teaching because we want you to have your pink card when we begin class sign-ups.

LATE SIGN-UP POLICY

If you know you will not be able to make the registration date, you can call Lesley Petty to let her know ahead of time. **The deadline for this is January 23rd at 8:00 am.** By doing this, we will not be signing your family's classes up until after everyone else has registered on sign-up day. This could mean that you do not get in the classes you want. You must also call Alisha McCarter by this date to sign-up for a volunteer position before we sign up you family's classes. We will need your first choice of classes plus a list of alternate classes incase you do not make it into the first pick. You must then mail payment to Lesley Petty. Our contact info is in our newsletter and on the membership list. We will not sign up anyone past registration date.
