

## 2010 EAGLE FALL ENRICHMENT CLASSES INFORMATION PACKET

Dear Parents and Students,

Summer is almost over and it's time to begin coming back to our ten weeks of enrichment classes. There is a LOT of information contained in these pages, so let us explain.

On these top two pages you will find important dates to put on your calendar and changes that will begin this fall semester. Please read through all the descriptions. We will be at a new church with a few new rules.

For those of you that have been members several years, you might remember that everyone who participated in enrichment classes had to sign an agreement to obey our class rules. This year we will bring that back in with updates for the current year. In this packet of class info, you will have a copy of that to sign to give us at registration. As usual, we will have our Statement of Faith for teachers to sign at registration along with a medical release form for all students to be signed by their parents. We hope you will read over the EAGLE Behavior and Dress Standards because it applies to classes as well.

In the next pages you will find the classes we are able to offer to our members this fall. The bulk of our classes will be at Farmington Baptist Church! A few classes will be held other places and they are marked as outside classes. For the main Tuesday classes held at FBC, we have 3 periods of classes as usual. Classes start at noon and last one hour each period. Classes are listed in the following pages organized by period and then within each period from youngest to oldest. As in years past, there are several classes where the teacher is teaching the same class on different periods and sometimes to different age children. Try to make note of this ahead of time so that at sign-up so you are not confused during that busy morning.

Registration Day will take place Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. You must be a member of EAGLE to participate in any EAGLE activities (join by paying through the mail, at orientation night or on registration day). Teachers only may come at 9:30 to sign-up. Everyone else needs to come at 10:30 for sign-up. Teachers, plan to stay through both registrations so that we can make changes and update cancellations while you are there. It is vital that teachers stay for the entire time! To help parents with little ones during this morning, we have several of our older youth that will take care of young children during this time. Because some classes are extremely popular and fill-up fast, please have second choices ready for each of your children. We will be enforcing the maximum number each teacher allows and cannot ask teachers to go over that limit. Fortunately, many classes are held again in our spring semester. On registration day you will be able to tour FBC and see when each classes is planned to be.

The first week of classes will begin two weeks later on September 14th. The last day of classes will be November 16th. Our Fall Creation night will be held November 19th.

NEW this year!! We will begin holding an assembly for everyone to meet before first period. During our first day of classes, we will meet in the sanctuary at 11:30 and dismiss children with their teachers so everyone can easily make the transition to a bigger church and layout. Teachers, we ask that you plan to attend the first assembly meeting so that kids and parents can follow you to classrooms and we thank you in advance for this help. For the second week of Tuesday classes through the last week assembly time will be at 11:45. We will meet for a short time to say the pledges, hear announcements and be led in a short devotion from an area pastor. Kathleen Fox will be our leader for assembly. We are all excited about this new time to join together each Tuesday and hope all of our families will try to come.

FBC has a very nice playground parents can take their children to during class hours. You may also picnic on their grounds because we do not need to bring food or drinks into the church. If a teacher needs to bring in refreshments, we ask that you let the enrichment class committee prior to the day. We will have on hand tablecloths to help with messes. Most of the rooms inside the church are carpeted, which is a change from other churches we have used in the past for classes.

The enrichment class committee has been working since the spring to insure these fall classes to continue to be a success. Although you may not understand why we do certain things we do or why we feel so strongly about enforcing rules, please trust us that we have always prayed about each decision and sought several members' opinions before making rules for classes. Below you will find the rest of our new policies that are included in the class rules and regulations you will be signing. Please note this is in addition to the EAGLE Behavior and Dress Standards already in place.

- Before signing up for any of the classes, each family must volunteer to help unless they are already teaching or on the enrichment committee. EAGLE will now have a committee member to solely confirm volunteers are doing their job. We will have sign-up sheets out during the first of our registration time instead of at the end as we have done in the past. You will not be allowed to register for classes unless you have volunteered to help clean-up, take-down, assist with Creation night, substitute teach, or be a teacher's assistant. These are the spots pertaining only to Tuesday classes that we absolutely must have your support on. Families: *please* prayerfully consider where you should help. This year we will be much more aggressive in holding folks accountable that do not show-up for their assigned duties. A group of our size cannot have these classes without the involvement of parents doing their part!
- First-time teachers will be assigned an assistant for their first time teaching regardless of their membership time in our group.
- We have a new late-sign up policy this year. Please read carefully because this is completely new. If you know you will not be able to make the registration date, you can email Stacey Posey at [Stacey.posey@gmail.com](mailto:Stacey.posey@gmail.com) to let her know ahead-of-time. **The deadline for this is Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup> at 8 a.m.** By doing this, we will not be signing your family's classes up until after the registration day. This could mean that you do not get in the classes you want. Signing up for a volunteer position first will have to be done by email before Stacey signs up your family's classes. Although this option is discouraged, we will not charge a late fee when you contact her by the above date and time with your info: volunteer position, classes plus a list of alternate classes in case you do not make it into the first pick. You must then mail or drop-off a check to Kim Crane by Saturday, September 4<sup>th</sup>. (By mailing your check(s) by our deadline, Kim should receive your check by this date. Kim's email is [klcrane@frontiernet.net](mailto:klcrane@frontiernet.net). Kim phone number is 438-7310). In the past we have signed up families on the first and second days of classes. We will not do that this year. It creates a chaotic state for our committee and the teachers. By having these deadline dates, we can give teachers an accurate count of students in their classes. For a group as large as ours, we are redefining how to improve the classes and this will be very helpful when followed. Teachers can email or call us after September 4<sup>th</sup> to get a final count for their classes. It is best families attend registration day. If this late policy is abused we will have to put in place even stricter rules.

Since our group is growing every year, we felt that we have to have these rules so things can be ran more efficient. ***Our main goal is to make sure our children receive the best classes possible and the parents are getting what they pay for.*** All the above changes and fine details may seem like we are taking the fun out of classes, but we are just getting it out of the way first so that the rest of the time can be a time of learning and enjoyment. Taking care of our new church facility is of the utmost significance.

**EAGLE Enrichment Classes Rules and Regulations:**

1. Please do not bring outsiders or those not enrolled in classes to the enrichment classes unless approved by the enrichment class coordinators or Keith and Kathleen Fox.
  2. No kids should leave classes early without a parent or guardian contacting a teacher. Be on time!
  3. If your child is taking classes, one person per family MUST volunteer in some way. This can be a parent or responsible teenager. We will have positions available for substitute teachers, assistant teachers, creation night, setting up, and taking down. Volunteer positions will have to be signed up before being able to register for classes. Persons signing up to volunteer in whatever position will be held accountable for their work. If volunteer fails to show up and help repeatedly then that person may be asked not to participate in classes again.
  4. If making payments, you must pay with 3 post dated checks upon registration. Dates will be given at class sign ups.
  5. There will be NO refund for classes unless approved by committee or presidents. We encourage our parents to investigate classes before signing up. Please make sure there are no conflicts of interest before placing your child in the class. Teachers will gladly give you a class description and list of snacks if needed. It is the parents responsibility to make sure that the class is suitable for your child.
  6. There will be no public display of affection during school hours.
  7. Enrolled students on premises should be in class. There will be no roaming in the halls. Students found roaming the halls will be given something to do. Classes are also held in the family life center and sanctuary. Students should refrain from loitering in these areas as well unless they are enrolled in the ongoing classes. All students should be under an adult's supervision.
  8. No skate boards, roller blades, bikes, etc in the parking lot.
  9. If unable to attend registration day for classes, we will take an email up to the 2 days before registration. You will be registered for classes after all others have signed up. We will take one choice per child per period. Classes are first come first serve bases and being at signups would ensure a better chance for your child to get the class he/she wants. Checks must be mailed and received by the Friday following class sign ups. We understand emergencies arise and are sympathetic to these situations. If this is the case upon approval by the enrichment class coordinators or eagle presidents exceptions may be made.
  10. Students cannot bring food or drinks into classes with them. If a teacher plans to have refreshments in her classroom, he/she needs to discuss this with a member of the enrichment class committee.
- \*\*Please do not be offended by these rules and regulations. We are growing by leaps and bounds and we must have rules to run smoothly. Please have respect for these rules and the church building! If these rules are not followed, you may be asked not to participate next in our enrichment classes.
